## Education

Strengthen and support local immunization coalitions' capacity

- Coordinate the Education Hour, CIC's webinars on local and current vaccine issues
- Conduct needs assessments and identify target areas for programs
- Develop and oversee technical assistance strategies

## Health Disparities

Promote evidence-based strategies to close gaps in immunization rates and to reduce health disparities

- Partner with various organizations to raise awareness about ethnic disparities
- Identify speakers and technical experts to meet local coalitions' needs
- Design and test culturally-appropriate messages

Identify and analyze emerging issues important to and/or unique to immunizations
