Peter Szilagyi is a Professor of Pediatrics, Executive Vice-Chair of the Department of Pediatrics, and Vice-Chair for Clinical Research at UCLA. For more than 2 decades, he has studied strategies to improve immunization rates for child, adolescent and adult vaccines. He is very interested in dissemination and implementation and scaling up successful interventions in primary care and public health.

Since September 2016 he has served as a voting member of the

Advisory Commission on Immunization Practices or ACIP. He chairs ACIP's HPV working group, and is a member of ACIP's influenza and child and adolescent working groups. ACIP has been meeting monthly since the pandemic regarding COVID-19 vaccines. In November 2020 he was named by Governor Newsom as a member of the California (now the Western States) COVID-19 Vaccine Scientific Safety Review Workgroup that will review the safety of COVID-19 vaccines for California and also for the states of Washington, Oregon, and Nevada.
