Dear Colleagues,

Yesterday's news that every member of the CDC's Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) has been dismissed by the Secretary of Health and Human Services is not only deeply alarming, but also unprecedented. For 64 years, ACIP has been a cornerstone of evidence-based vaccine policy in the United States, providing the scientific foundation that underpins our national immunization schedule and guides an essential portion of our collective work to protect public health and ensure healthy communities.

A credible, centralized body to develop and maintain immunization schedules has been critical to the work we do. Without it, we now face the very real possibility that jurisdictions may begin crafting their own immunization recommendations if federal guidance is no longer sufficient to support the prevention and control of vaccine-preventable diseases. What has long been a shared, science-driven process could quickly fracture into a patchwork of conflicting policies and recommendations. The implications for public health, interoperability, and trust in immunization systems are significant and cannot be overstated.

In the face of politicization and chaos, immunization information systems (IIS) may become more important than ever and are uniquely positioned to be a source of consistency. IIS have long stood as trusted, data-driven infrastructures that ensure vaccines are delivered safely, effectively, and equitably. AIRA remains committed to supporting the IIS community as we navigate what may be an uncertain and rapidly-shifting future. We will work with you, our partners, and public health leaders to uphold the principles of evidence-based decision making, maintain clarity in implementation, and champion the essential role IIS play in protecting our communities.

PhRMA Statement on ACIP Membership Changes WASHINGTON, D.C. (June 9, 2025) –

Pharmaceutical Research and Manufacturers of America (PhRMA) Senior Director of Public Affairs Andrew Powaleny issued the following statement: “Today’s action is concerning for public health and the millions of Americans who benefit from vaccines. Vaccines undergo rigorous testing and review by the FDA. ACIP’s independent experts then inform CDC recommendations that play a critical role in ensuring vaccines are covered by health plans and affordable for patients. Upending the ACIP membership increases uncertainty and vaccine skepticism, undermining the health gains achieved through vaccination.”
